Aim of Internship is to extend and expand knowledge acquired in basic and specialization courses, to introduce students to the production, design, research or support tasks in a company or organization, to train students in solving real practical tasks, to help in acquiring communication and collaboration skills. During the Internship, student must execute functions, requiring the qualification of an informatics specialist, at an accepting company or organization. Report must be prepared covering the main types of Internship activities – analysis of company activities, processes and ICT infrastructure, description of Internship task and its implementation, results and conclusions.
